Moral - it doesn't really matter if you are really are passionate about something than there is no force or power in this world which can stop you ,making efforts and being passionate about something is all you need.

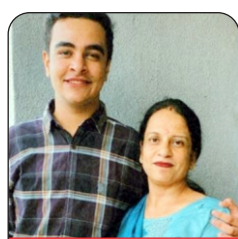
